



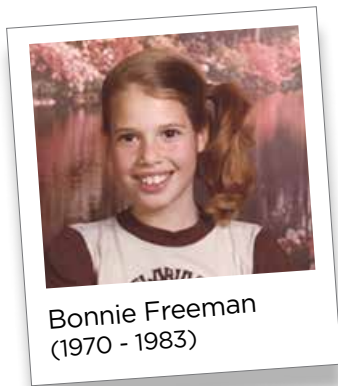

Bonnie Freeman
(1970 - 1983)

In 1981, after being diagnosed with leukemia at the age of ten, Bonnie Freeman told her parents she wanted to help other children like her who had cancer, so that others wouldn't have to go through what she and her family had gone through.

Following this bright vision, Bonnie, her family and two family friends founded Stop Children's Cancer. For two and a half years, Bonnie joyfully participated in writing and stuffing letters, helping with bake sales and doing whatever it took to let others know about Stop Children's Cancer.

Though Bonnie lost her battle with cancer, her family and friends continued Bonnie's vision and the work that she had started.

The selfless dream of this one child has resulted in almost \$6 million in donations to help fund pediatric cancer research at the University of Florida's College of Medicine.

Since 1981, Stop Children's Cancer has continued to raise funds for basic research, scholars, equipment and technology, including clinical trials for the Divisions of Pediatric Hematology/Oncology and Pediatric Neuro-Oncology at the University of Florida College of Medicine. The funding of this research through clinical trials will bring life-saving drugs to children and young adults with cancer and provide hope for their future.

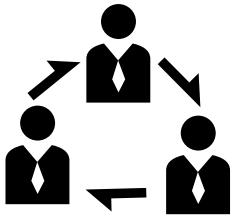

During a clinical trial, researchers test the latest advancements in medication or treatment. These trials do not involve placebos, so each patient enrolled receives treatment. Patients involved in trials make an important contribution in advancing new treatments for cancer.
